The “Native American 40 Under 40” award recognizes forty emerging American Indian leaders from across Indian Country who have demonstrated leadership, initiative, dedication and have made significant contributions in business and/or their community.

Mr. Patterson received his Juris Doctor from the University of Wisconsin Law School in 2002 and joined FPM in 2006. He is a member of the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe (Miniconjou/ Itazipco Lakota).
